# **GROUP LEARNING GOALS**

First Grade Students are working to secure the sound of each alphabet letter quickly and correctly on a consistent basis. They are also working on Phonemic Awareness, which is the ability to hear, separate, and manipulate the sounds in words.

Second Grade Students are working to read and spell consonant-vowel-consonant words correctly and efficiently; words such as

gap, lip, fed, etc.) Some students are working to hear, identify, & read words with consonant blends & digraphs (tr, st, sh, ch, etc.) All students work on these patterns in individual words as well as while reading text. They are also working to master high-frequency words.

Third Grade Students are learning to identify and read words ending with double consonants (-ff, -11, -gg) We are using Phonics for

Reading workbooks which practice these types of words individually as well as in connected text.
