Your child, _____, has been identified to participate in the Perry Elementary School Title I Reading Program. Title I is a federal program that assists schools in funding additional support for students in core content areas. The purpose is to help all students achieve success in meeting academic expectations.

Three times a year, all students at Perry Elementary School take part in school wide reading assessments. Your child's teacher and the Title I Reading staff have reviewed the results of your child's initial reading assessments. Based on a careful review of these measures, your child was identified to receive Title I Reading intervention. Your child will receive this extra instruction from Title I staff in a small group setting. Title I instruction is supplemental, and does not take the place of regular classroom instruction.

The goal of the Perry Elementary Title I staff is to work together with families in order to ensure academic success for students. Your family is a necessary part of your child's reading and writing success.
